AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETH, IN THE COUNTY OF UNION, NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION PURSUANT TO *N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53* TO FUND ACCUMULATED ABSENCE LIABILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Elizabeth, in the County of Union, New Jersey, has accrued accumulated absence liabilities due to retirements in the fiscal year 2011 budget year, and

WHEREAS, *N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(h)* permits a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey to adopt an Ordinance authorizing a special emergency appropriation in order to fund the cost of severance liabilities resulting from the retirement of employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETH, IN THE COUNTY OF UNION, NEW JERSEY (not less than a majority of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Elizabeth is hereby authorized to incur a special emergency appropriation pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53* in order to fund the cost of accumulated absence liabilities resulting from retirements in fiscal year 2011.
2. Upon final adoption of this Ordinance, the City Council shall pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55* adopt a Resolution setting forth the amount appropriated for this accumulated absence liability and further setting forth how the City will finance such appropriation.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.
