ORDINANCE NO. 4192

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AN ENCROACHMENT PERMIT TO PHOENIX ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, INC., 3525 QUAKERBRIDGE ROAD, HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY 08619 AS PART OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ONE (1) MONITORING WELL IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY AT THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH FIFTH STREET AND FOURTH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Division of Engineering has reviewed an application submitted to the City of Elizabeth by Phoenix Environmental Management, Inc., on behalf of John and Grace Monaco, the former property owners at 335 South Fifth Street, to install a monitoring well in the sidewalk area of 335 South Fifth Street; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETH:

SECTION 1. - That an encroachment permit be granted to Phoenix Environmental Management, Inc., 3525 Quakerbridge Road, Hamilton, New Jersey 08619 as part of New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection case #88092097-1647-42 for the installation of one (1) monitoring well in the public right-of-way at the intersection of South Fifth Street and Fourth Avenue.

SECTION 2. - All documentation submitted appears to be in order, which are on file in the City Engineer's Office.

SECTION 3. - The Permittee shall provide a liability insurance certificate in the aggregate amount determined by the City Engineer for property damage and personal injury naming the City of Elizabeth as an additional insured and giving the City a thirty (30) day notice of cancellation of policy. The Permittee shall also be responsible for all maintenance with regard to the encroachment.

SECTION 4. - All ordinances or parts of ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. - If any portion or clause of this ordinance is declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, same shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other part or portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. - The effective date of this ordinance shall be twenty (20) days after its final passage by City Council and approval by the Mayor at the time and in the manner provided by law.
