

ORDINANCE NO. 4798

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 10.40.070 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETH ENTITLED "NO PARKING OF TRUCKS-PORTION AFFECTED" SPECIFICALLY TO ADD NEW POINT ROAD FROM SOUTH PARK STREET TO BROADWAY, BOTH SIDES, AND NO TRUCK PARKING ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF BROADWAY FROM FOURTH STREET AND FIFTH STREET; AND TO AMEND CHAPTER 10.08.010 ENTITLED "FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTION" SPECIFICALLY TO ADD A FOUR-WAY STOP AT SOUTH PARK STREET AND NEW POINT ROAD, AND A FOUR-WAY STOP AT LIVINGSTON STREET AND SIXTH STREET; TO AMEND CHAPTER 10.08.020 ENTITLED "STOP INTERSECTIONS DESIGNATED" SPECIFICALLY TO ADD A STOP SIGN FACING BROADWAY AT THE INTERSECTION OF SIXTH STREET.

WHEREAS, the Director of the Police Department has recommended that an ordinance be adopted for add No Truck Parking at New Point Road from South Park Street to Broadway, both sides, and along the North side of Broadway from Fourth Street to Fifth Street; and add a four-way stop intersection on South Park Street and New Point Road, and Livingston Street and Sixth Street; and for a stop intersection facing Broadway at the intersection of Sixth Street; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELIZABETH:

SECTION 1. - That Chapter 10.40.070, "No Parking of Trucks" of the Code of the City of Elizabeth be amended to add the following:

STREET	SIDE	LOCATION
New Point Road	Both	South Park Street to Broadway
Broadway	North	Fourth Street to Fifth Street

SECTION 2. - That Chapter 10.08.010, "Four-Way Stop Intersections" of the Code of the City of Elizabeth be amended to add the following:

South Park Street and New Point Road. Stop signs shall be installed as provided.

Livingston Street and Sixth Street. Stop signs shall be installed as provided.

SECTION 3. - That Chapter 10.08.020, "Stop Intersections Designated" of the Code of the City of Elizabeth be amended to add the following:

Establish a stop intersection facing Broadway at the intersection of Sixth Street.

SECTION 4. - The administrative and enforcement aspects of this Ordinance shall be under the jurisdiction of the Police Department of the City of Elizabeth.

SECTION 5. - All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. - If any portion or clause of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, same shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other part or portion of this Ordinance.
